

MCC Campership FAQ's



Q What is a Campership?

A The Vision Statement of the Michigan Crossroads Council is *"To create an organization that focuses on Exceptional Scouting Program in every community – ensuring that every youth in Michigan has an opportunity to join and participate."* Participation includes our outdoor programs and a Campership is the vehicle to financially assist those Scouts in need of help in getting to camp this summer.

Q Where does the money for Camperships come from?

A Campership funds are raised and administered locally by our 4 MCC Field Service Councils.

Q How much money is awarded for a Campership?

A Scouts who qualify typically may receive up to ½ of the camp fee they are applying for.

Q How does a Scout apply for a Campership?

A The Campership Application is currently available on the MCC website at the following location:

Q When is the Campership Application due?

A The Campership Application is due at your Field Service Council Service Center no later than March 15th. The address for each Field Service Council can be found on the Campership Application or the MCC website. Campership Applications received after March 15th will be reviewed only if funds are available.

Q What events can a MCC Campership be used for?

A MCC Camperships can be used for the following MCC events; Boy Scout Resident Camp, Cub Scout Day Camp or Resident Camp. MCC Camperships can be used for MCC Field Service Council, District, Area, or National Training Conference or MCC Field Service Council managed NYLT (National Youth Leader Training).

Q How will I know if I receive a Campership?

A Your Field Service Council Service Center will contact you directly with the results of your Campership Application by April 30th. All approved Boy Scout Summer Camp Camperships will be posted to your individual Boy Scout Summer Camp online account on or before May 1st. Your final summer camp payments are due by May 10th. Please refer to the specified payment deadline for other qualified Campership programs.

Q Do I have to pay the Boy Scout Summer Camp Fee payment of \$145 before I receive word on the status of my Campership?

A Yes. Since Camperships are awarded for up to ½ of the Camp Fee, your Boy Scout Summer Camp payment of \$145 (approximately ½ of the Camp Fee) is still due at the time of registration for camp.

- Q Is my \$145 Camp Fee payment refundable if I do not receive a Campership?

Individuals/Groups that cancel their reservations 30 days or more prior to the event date will receive a refund of fees paid less a 15% administrative service charge. No refunds will be given for cancellations made less than 30 days prior to the event date. The MCC Spring Popcorn Sale is an excellent opportunity to raise additional funds for summer camp!
- Q How do I apply for a refund of the Camp Fees I have currently paid?
A Please submit a written request for a refund to: Michigan Crossroads Council/Attn: Camp Fee Refunds, 507 W Atherton Road, Flint MI 48507-2407.
- Q Why do I need to submit a W-2 Form?
A To make sure that Camperships are awarded to Scouts who truly need financial assistance, a W-2 Form is required to help establish family income and need. Be sure to mask personal identification information such as Social Security numbers. If a W-2 Form is not available, please contact your Field Service Council Service Center.
- Q What happens if I leave part of the Campership Application blank?
A Any incomplete Campership Applications will not be considered and returned to the applicant.
- Q How do I send a Thank-You note to those who made my Campership possible?
A Please contact your Field Service Council Service Center for information on who made your Campership possible.



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
